Echo Cup

This year City of Liverpool SC are holding the Echo Cup at our pool, Knowsley Leisure & Culture Park for the first time.

The Echo Cup is a competition for 9-12 year olds and consists of two rounds of galas with the top 8 going through to the final which is a fantastic occasion which includes a parade of the swimmers before the event.

The dates are: Sat 30 August, either 1pm or 4pm (we swim in 1 of the 2 galas) Sat 27 September, 1pm or 4pm Sat 25 October - the final if we qualify - 1pm

This is one of the biggest swimming events of the year in Liverpool and if everyone selected can make it we are sure we can do well.

Land training will also be closing for the summer and will resume on Tuesday 26th Aug.


