	Functional Ability Cards (FAC's) must be submitted to the Recording Desk / Referee prior to the start of the session with the athletes' first event. No further submission is required following this. Failure to do so will result in the swimmer being unable to race.						
	The competition shall take place under the relevant IPC Swimming, Swimming Rules.						
	Accreditation All coaches and personal care attendants must have accreditation. Personal care attendants will only be permitted for swimmers in the following classes: S1, S2, S3, S4 and S11. 
